Important Dates

October 1 - FAFSA Opens for the 2023-2024 Academic Year! You must renew this each year that you are enrolled to receive federal and state aid.

October 13 - Mid-term Grades (Tigerville) - Grades will be available on the student portal by noon. Questions regarding grades should be emailed to your professor.

October 14 - (Tigerville) Last day to add Traditional Fall 2 Course Offerings.

October 16 - (Tigerville) Last day to add NGU Online Fall 2 Course Offerings.

Courses can be viewed in your My.NGU portal by selecting *Fall 2022 - Traditional Term 2* or *Fall 2022 - CAPS Term 2*. To add an online course, students will need to complete a *Permission to Take Online Course* form found on the Forms and Information page in your My.NGU Portal and collect all necessary signatures before submitting to Academic Records.

FERPA

Family Educational
Rights & Privacy Act

WHAT IS FERPA? The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA), as amended, requires that students be advised of their rights concerning their education records and of certain categories of public information which the University has designated "directory information". The law applies to all schools that receive funds under an applicable program of the U.S. Department of Education. All students who want to authorize other individuals to have access to any of their student education records must set FERPA permissions by logging into their student portal.

- Log into your [My.NGU](#) portal
- Select Students
- Select Forms and Information
- Locate the section called Set FERPA Permissions
- Click Define FERPA Permissions

Want to get your refund faster? Sign up for Direct Deposit in your [My.NGU](#) portal today. you can now sign up for Direct Deposit on the Student Account page. Signing up will get you any refund owed more quickly. You can sign up using your own personal checking or savings account. Have your routing and bank account number ready to get started.



If you are planning to graduate in May 2023, apply for graduation now! Early application is imperative to provide ample time for the Academic Records team to complete your graduation audit. The audit verifies that you have completed or will complete all necessary requirements to earn your degree. If something is missing, this allows time for you to make necessary adjustments to your schedule.

To locate the Application for Graduation in your portal, follow this path: Students tab>Forms and Information>Student Forms>Application for Graduation. Applications received after December 1st will incur a \$50 late fee.
